

My Rights in my Out of School Club

Did you know that all children have rights which are protected by law?

Children's rights are a list of the things you need to grow up feeling happy, healthy and safe. The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) has articles that set out these rights. For more information please scan the QR code.



I have the right to

be the best I can be.

Article 29



In my club, I can/will:

- Experience and develop my understanding of my fundamental rights.
- Have time and space to develop my social, emotional and physical talents and abilities through play.
- Be respected and respect others and the world around me.
- Be encouraged to develop to my full potential.
- Be treated with dignity.

Other ways my club can support my right:

- Provide for my individual needs and interests.
- Understand my and others' values and beliefs.
- Promote an understanding and appreciation of our different values and beliefs.
- Consistently provide time, space and effective resources for me to freely play and explore.

Playworkers can support this children's right by:

- Having a good understanding of my rights
- Help me respect myself and others.
- Promote respectful relationships.
- Give opportunities for physical, social and emotional play
- Support my understanding of the natural environment.

Guidance for Playworkers

- Watch the videos about Children's Rights with the children, on the Children's Commissioner for Wales website (QR code above).
- Talk with children.
- Consider the examples in the boxes above of how children's rights can be supported in Out of School Clubs and allow them to add their own ideas in the boxes. You could try other participation methods to gain their thoughts - [click here for ideas.](#)

General Comments strengthen each Article (right), raising its importance and increasing accountability among countries that have signed up to the Convention. Those linked to this Article are:

General Comment 1 (2001) which includes the preparation of the child for responsible life in a free society, in the spirit of understanding, peace, tolerance, equality of sexes, and friendship among all peoples, ethnic, national and religious groups and persons of indigenous origin. Also the development of respect for the natural environment.



Yn fy nghlwb, gallaf/mi fyddaf yn:

- Profi a datblygu fy nealltwriaeth o'm hawliau sylfaenol.
- Cael yr amser a'r lle i ddatblygu fy ngalluoedd cymdeithasol, emosiynol a chorfforol drwy chwarae.
- Cael fy mharchu, a pharchu eraill a'r byd o'm cwmpas.
- Cael anogaeth i ddatblygu i'm potensial llawn.
- Cael fy nhrin ag urddas.

Ffyrrd eraill y gall fy nghlwb gefnogi fy hawl:

- Darparu ar gyfer fy anghenion a'm diddordebau unigol.
- Deall fy ngwerthoedd a'm credoau fy hun a hynny o eiddo pobl eraill.
- Hybu dealltwriaeth a gwerthawrogiad o'n gwahanol werthoedd a chredoau.
- Rhoi yn gyson, yr amser, y lle a'r adnoddau effeithiol fel y gallaf i chwarae ac ymchwilio yn rhydd.

Gall Gweithwyr Chwarae gefnogi'r hawl plant hwn trwy:

- Bod â dealltwriaeth dda o'm hawliau.
- Fy helpu i'm parchu fy hunan ac eraill.
- Hyrwyddo perthnasoedd parchus.
- Rhoi cyfleoedd am chwarae corfforol, cymdeithasol ac emosiynol.
- Cefnogi fy nealltwriaeth o'r amgylchedd naturiol.
