Beach House Fun Club – Case study Camau

Beach House Fun Club is a bilingual day nursery situated in St Thomas's Church House in Rhyl Denbighshire. They offer both After School and Holiday Clubs providing quality care for children aged 2 and a half to 11 years, with caring and qualified staff to promote children's play and development.

Beach House Fun Club started their Welsh language journey on the Welsh Promise after attending Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs Clwb Hwb on Introducing Welsh in October. Following an onsite visit by Eiliw Pierce, Welsh Language Childcare Business Development Officer, Beach House Fun Club decided to embark on the Bronze Promise. Their action plan highlighted that the staff wanted to improve their Welsh language skills and therefore they decided to also embark on the Camau Learn Welsh course.

Clwb Hwyl Y Traeth – Astudiaeth Achos

Meithrinfa ddydd ddwyieithog yn Nhŷ Eglwys St Thomas yn y Rhyl, Sir Ddinbych yw Clwb Hwyl Y Traeth. Maent yn cynnig Clybiau Ôl-ysgol a Chlybiau Gwyliau sy'n darparu gofal o safon i blant 2 a hanner i 11 blwydd oed, gyda staff gofalgar a chymwys i hybu chwarae a datblygiad plant.

Dechreuodd Clwb Hwyl Y Traeth eu taith Gymraeg ar yr Addewid Cymraeg ar ôl mynychu Clwb Hwb Clybiau Plant Cymru ar Cyflwyno'r Gymraeg ym mis Hydref. Yn dilyn ymweliad â'r safle gan Eiliw Pierce, Swyddog Datblygu Busnes Gofal Plant Cymraeg, penderfynodd Clwb Hwyl Beach House gychwyn ar yr Addewid Efydd. Tynnwyd sylw yn eu cynllun gweithredu fod y staff yn awyddus i wella eu sgiliau Cymraeg ac felly fe wnaethant benderfynu hefyd i gychwyn ar gwrs dysgu Cymraeg Camau.

Beach House Fun Club enrolled 11 members of staff onto the Camau course. Sian Brownley of Beach House Fun Club has since completed Entry part 1 along with 4 other members of staff and stated that she “Would recommend the Camau course as it helps the staff that have lost a bit of the Welsh Language, and it also gave the other staff new skills to develop their Welsh language skills” Staff also liked “how easy it was to follow the course”.

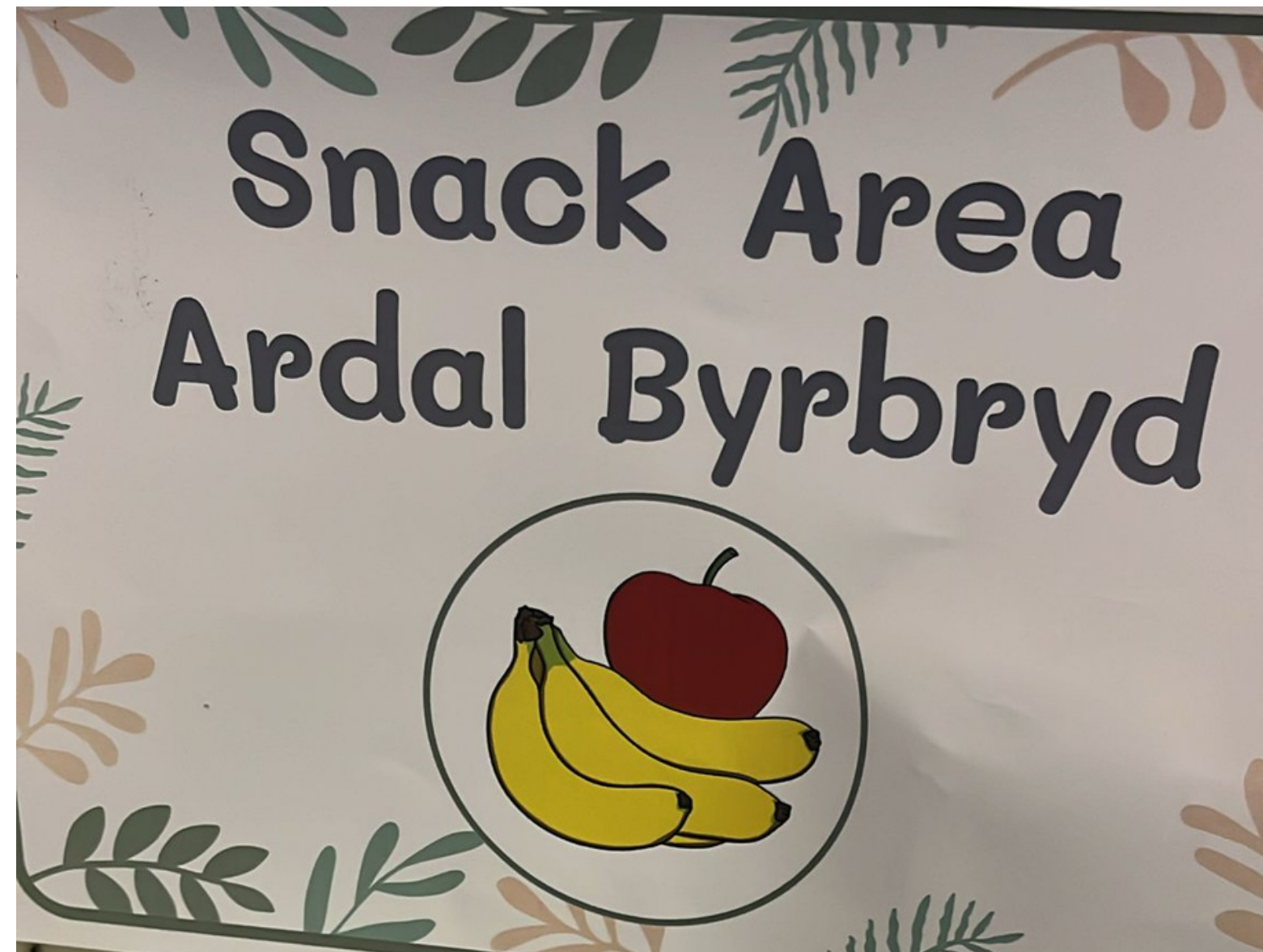


Cofrestrodd Clwb Hwyl Y Traeth 11 aelod o staff ar gwrs Camau. Ers hynny mae Sian Brownley, ynghyd â 4 aelod arall o staff o Glwb Hwyl Y Traeth, wedi cwblhau Mynediad rhan 1 a dywedodd “Byddwn i’n argymhell cwrs Camau gan ei fod yn helpu’r staff sydd wedi colli ychydig o’r Gymraeg, ac fe roddodd hefyd ffyrdd newydd i staff eraill i ddatblygu eu sgiliau Cymraeg” Roedd staff hefyd yn hoffi “pa mor hawdd oedd dilyn y cwrs”.

Throughout their journey on the Bronze Welsh Promise, Beach House Fun Club have diligently worked through their action plan with the support of Eiliw Pierce, making sure every detail was taken care of in terms of the environment, family engagement and Welsh language development through the Camau course.

Increasing the use of Welsh was very important to Beach House Fun Club. They are committed to increasing the use of Welsh within the setting and stated that by using more Welsh it will support “the children in our area that go to English schools to become bilingual and also support the children that go to Welsh school develop their vocabulary more. We would love the staff to feel more confident using the Welsh language”.



Drwy gydol eu taith ar yr Addewid Cymraeg Efydd, mae Clwb Hwyl Y Traeth wedi gweithio'n ddiwyd trwy eu cynllun gweithredu gyda chefnogaeth Eiliw Pierce, gan sicrhau y rhoddwyd sylw i bob manylyn o ran yr amgylchedd, ymgysylltu â theuluoedd a datblygu eu Cymraeg drwy gwrs Camau.

Roedd cynyddu'r defnydd o'r Gymraeg yn bwysig iawn i Glwb Hwyl Y Traeth. Maent wedi ymrwymo i gynyddu'r defnydd o'r Gymraeg yn y lleoliad gan ddatgan y byddai defnyddio mwy o Gymraeg yn cefnogi “plant ein hardal sy'n mynd i ysgolion Saesneg i ddod yn ddwyieithog a hefyd yn cefnogi'r plant sy'n mynd i'r ysgol Gymraeg i ddatblygu eu geirfa'n fwy. Byddem wrth ein bodd yn gweld y staff yn teimlo'n fwy hyderus wrthi ddefnyddio'r Gymraeg”.

When asked what the barriers were regarding Welsh Language Development in the sector Sian Brownley said that “our barriers have been that some of our staff are English speaking and didn't know there is support out there to develop Welsh language skills.”

With the help of Camau, the Welsh Promise and the support from Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs the setting has become a lot more confident

Beach House Fun Club continues to work extremely hard ensuring that the Welsh Language and culture is seen and heard throughout the setting. “The staff have become more confident in using basic Welsh language skills. I find we do have support from Eiliw and she is always there to support us.”



Pan ofynnwyd iddi beth oedd y rhwystrau o ran Datblygu'r Gymraeg yn y sector, dywedodd Sian Brownley mai “ein rhwystrau oedd bod rhai o'n staff yn Saesneg eu hiaith a heb wybod bod cymorth ar gael i ddatblygu sgiliau Cymraeg.”

Gyda chymorth Camau, yr Addewid Cymraeg a chefnogaeth Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs mae'r lleoliad wedi dod yn llawer mwy hyderus.

Mae Clwb Hwyl Y Traeth yn parhau i weithio'n galed iawn gan sicrhau bod y Gymraeg a diwylliant Cymru yn cael eu gweld a'u clywed ym mhob rhan o'r lleoliad. “Mae'r staff wedi dod yn fwy hyderus wrth ddefnyddio sgiliau Cymraeg sylfaenol. Rwy'n gweld ein bod yn cael ein cefnogi gan Eiliw ac mae hi yno bob amser i wneud hynny.”
